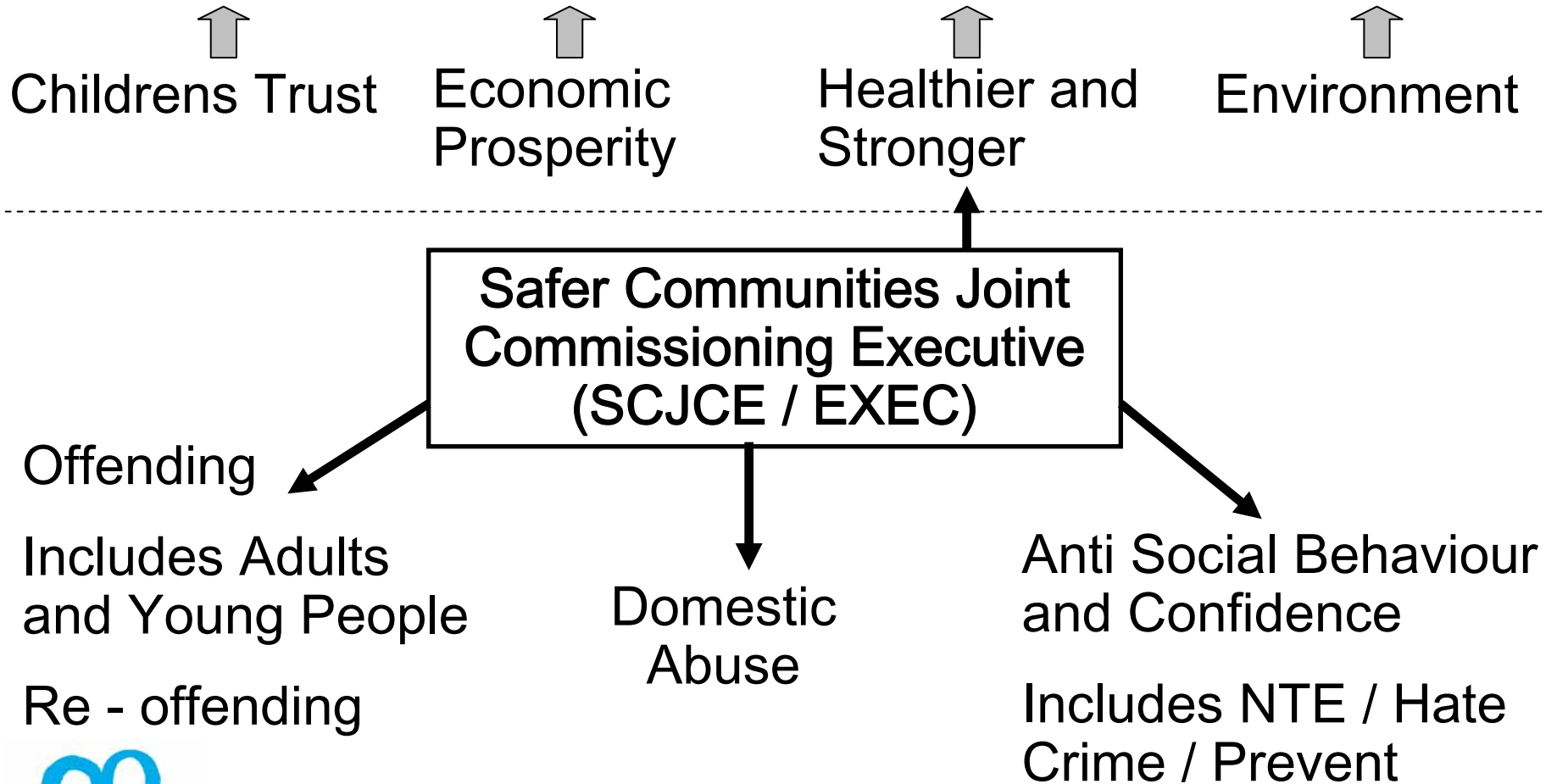

- Monitor performance and evaluation, highlight opportunities and risks and celebrate success.
- Make recommendations to SCJCE.
- Maximise funding opportunities.
- Identify efficiency savings.

Your Targets Are Our Targets

- DV Sanction Detections - £250k
- Reduce Multi Agency Risk Assessment Conference Repeat Rate - £250k
- Reduce night time alcohol related assaults - £250k
- Reduce the number of young people who re-offend - £150k
- Increase No. of people who feel informed about what we are doing to tackle ASB - £100k

Your Targets Are Our Targets

- ASB and Confidence
 - Dealing with local concerns about ASB and Crime
 - Reduce number of ASB complaints reported to the police in Hele and Foxhole / QED
 - Perceptions of drunk and rowdy behaviour
 - Reduce Night Time Economy related violent crime
- Road traffic collisions

Your Targets Are Our Targets

- Domestic Abuse
 - Sanction detections
 - Repeat incidents of DV
 - Multi Agency Risk Assessment Conference repeat rate
 - Specialist Domestic Violence Court conviction rate
 - Reduce number of children with child protection plan whose parent is subject to MARAC process

Your Targets Are Our Targets

- Offending
 - 1st time entrants to youth justice system
 - Serious violence, serious acquisitive crime
 - Re-offending rate of adults and young people
 - Prolific and Priority Offender Scheme
 - Drug related offending rate
 - Offenders living in suitable accommodation etc
